Application for Membership in the American Association of Biological Anthropologists

Membership in the AABA is by election at the annual business meeting of the Association (usually held in March or April) after approval by the Membership Chair. Thus all approved applicants are normally enrolled initially in a provisional status and receive the *American Journal of Physical Anthropology* and the *Yearbook of Physical Anthropology*. Applications must be accompanied by full annual dues payment. Payment must be in U.S. funds (see dues below) by check, MasterCard, VISA or American Express. REGULAR MEMBERSHIP

is open to professional anthropologists, advanced students showing evidence of professional capacity, professionals in cognate sciences, and others who have demonstrated qualification by publication or professional activities.

REGULAR POSTDOC/CONTIGENT FACULTY

AABA Considers this category to include those in temporary posdoctoral positions or non-tenure-line faculty positions.

STUDENT MEMBERSHIP

is open to bona fide students for a maximum of six years. Extensions for additional years are subject to annual reapplication.

SPECIAL MEMBERSHIP - FULL RATE

is open to persons with a professional interest in anthropology who do not meet the requirements for regular membership.

SPECIAL MEMBERSHIP - CONTINGENT RATE

is open to persons with a professional interest in anthropology who do not meet the requirements for regular membership, are in a temporary or a permanent position but do not have the 5 years of professional experience required for non-PhD Regular members.

RETIRED (EMERITUS/A) MEMBERSHIP

is available to regular members after normally 25 years in good standing who have retired. Retired members are relieved of payment of Association dues without impairment of standing but must continue to pay subscription costs to continue receiving Association publications.

QUALIFYING COUNTRY MEMBERSHIP

\$40 for regular and special membership and \$20 for student membership is available to residents of some countries. The AABA classifies a qualifying country as a Middle- or Low-income economy country according to the definitions of the World Bank.
